In fact, it was Sri Krishna, Draupadi called out to when she was being derobed by the Kaurav (second cousins of the Pandavas and their sworn enemies) prince Dushashan in the middle of the court after her husband Yudhishtir gambled and lost her in a game of chess. And ultimately Krishna protected her honour.

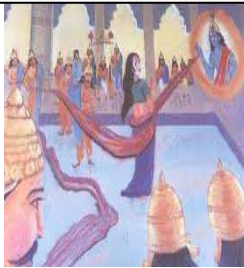
